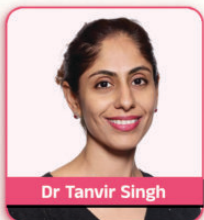

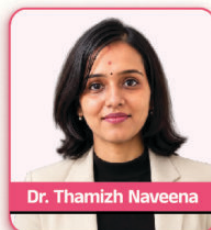

 Sacral neuromodulation	To understand how nueromodulation can reset dysfunctional pelvic pain pathways and improve outcomes in complex chronic pelvic pain syndromes
 Pelvic Physiotherapy	To empower clinicians with practical physiotherapy tools to identify and treat the musculoskeletal drivers of chronic pelvic pain.
 Urodynamics	To equip clinicians with practical skills to evaluate bladder dynamics, correlate findings with patient symptoms, and formulate evidence-based treatment pathways
 Cystoscopy Hysteroscopy	To equip gynaecologists with endoscopic skills to identify and manage uterine and bladder sources of chronic pelvic pain.
 Laser HIFEM CHAIR	To train clinicians in the indications, administration, and evidence-based use of laser therapy, for women with chronic pelvic pain.
 Botox PRP	To empower clinicians to safely evaluate, plan, and deliver targeted botulinum toxin and PRP therapies for refractory pelvic floor dysfunction and pain
 Robotic Surgery	To train clinicians in robotic pelvic surgery techniques, optimizing surgical precision and nerve-sparing approaches for complex pelvic pathology.

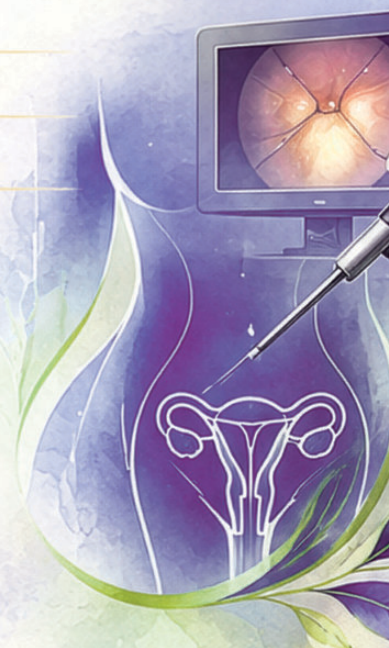

THIRUVANANTHAPURAM

The Evergreen Capital of Kerala – Where Heritage Meets Serenity

Thiruvananthapuram is Kerala's historic capital, renowned for royal heritage, museums, colonial architecture, pristine beaches and spiritual landmarks.
